Safety and Security

Safety and security of children is our prime concern. Security is taken care into every aspect right since the design and construction stage. 'Safe by design' is our commitment. The building is earthquake safe, and fire safety has been taken care of. Exposed columns (balustrades) of building have been rounded to keep children safe from accidental fall. Similarly on first floor and second floor 4 feet high strong rounded stainless steel grill has been fixed to prevent accidental fall. All switches and electrical fitting fixing is shock proof. All doors and windows have been designed in such a way that minimises the possibility of accident.

There is boundary wall around whole campus with entry exit regulations as per CBSE norms to protect children. We shall also organise lectures and interaction programmes to sensitize children and staff about disasters and various kinds of emergency responses within campus and in buses.

Washrooms are segregated for boys and girls and are also separate for different age group of children. Staff including class IV staff will use separate washrooms.

All class room furniture has been specially designed keeping child safety in mind. The edges of chair, desks and shelves have been rounded to prevent injury to children.

Our modern buses have safe seats and are equipped with CCTV, GPS monitored and fitted with Speed governess. Entry into buses is regulated with **RF enabled I-D cards**. It means that no unauthorised person can enter into bus if children are inside. Similarly no child can board wrong bus. As the child reaches School, an SMS will reach the parent on his /her mobile phone. Similarly as the child boards bus back to home, an SMS will inform the parents.

Since RF readers are fitted at various entry / exit of building and at school campus, child's attendance and presence in the School will be monitorable over computer system.

All classes, corridors, entry gate and campus are fitted with **70 + CCTV cameras**. It adds hugely to the safety and security of children inside School.

'**Ayah**' have been appointed for younger children to help them in washrooms and at sports ground.

To take care of children feeling sick in school, an **infirmary** (sick bay) has been established with 2 beds and a trained paramedical staff. First Aid kit is available in School.

Dangerous and violent computer and mobile games these days are major cause of concern for parents and society. Besides unhealthy material reaching to children is posing newer challenges. School will organise Expert Talks and debates to sensitize children from dangers of Cyber & mobile issues.

Corporal or physical punishment to children is completely banned in the School. Ragging and bullying shall be dealt strictly. Elder students will be sensitized to take care of little children with empathy.

Teaching and non teaching Staff

The entire Academic and non academic staff of the School is highly qualified, well trained, competent and committed to the school philosophy, values and mission. They have been chosen carefully keeping the all round development of child at the School as the centre piece of our Institutional values.

Our teachers take deep interest in the growth of children and take extra pains for that. They are encouraged to enhance their skills and qualifications through involvement in professional development programmes, training, retraining and refresher courses. Teachers take active interest in co-curricular activities and sports to be part of the lives of children.

Our teachers are not permitted to take private tuitions of any child and are encouraged to pay full attention to children studying in the School. If required, teachers are to take extra classes and remedial classes after regular school hours.

We encourage students to question and foster spirit of enquiry. We do not believe in making the child 'parrot' by cramming the course and writing the exam with sole purpose of securing marks. We encourage the child to be self learner and instil into them sense of responsibility, confidence and competence. We believe that classroom teaching is not the only method of learning. Observing, experimenting, enquiring, experiencing are also equally powerful and potential way of learning that we promote in this school.

We constantly review our teaching practices, methodology and contents and undertake externally validated assessment to ensure best possible education to the children.

Sports:

Games and sports play a very important role in physical and mental development of child. On sports grounds children learn to compete and cooperate in healthy environment. Students here can unleash their energy and imagination during play. Hockey legend late Shri Dhyan Chand titled popularly as 'Hockey magician' member of 3 Olympic gold medal winning Indian team is reigning sportsperson on the campus.

Various sports facilities are available in the campus like, Athletics track of 200 meters, Cricket, Football, Hockey, Volleyball, basketball, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Badminton, Yoga, Skating, Archery and badminton. In indoor games, we offer table tennis, Carrom, Chess and Judo.

Games and Sports are mandatory during 'Sports Hour' for all students unless specifically exempted by House masters on medical grounds. After School Hours, all students entitled to enjoy 'full membership' can avail all facilities till sunset at their choice. Expert coaches will be available to train the children. Students displaying extraordinary interest and skills shall be given additional special attention.

Extra Curricular / Co-curricular activities:

Talent lies hidden in every child. The only need is to explore and identify it and nurture it by parents and School.

School offers various extra- curricular, co-curricular and co-scholastic activities like Dance, Music- playing & Singing, Painting, Arts & crafts.

Scientific activities like experimentations, Explorations, Project work help children to learn in variety of ways. Study tours and excursions, visits to labs, factories, industries shall also be taken as part of curriculum.

Literary activities like, Debate, Recitations, Creative Writing, extempore presentation, Quiz, and talks by experts are some of our methods to impart education and learning skills.

School will have various clubs, each dedicated to a particular hobby like, Photography, Bird Watching, Star gazing to promote the spirit of respective Houses.

Our Uniform

The colour, design of clothes and pattern of stitching has been decided keeping in view the climate of the area, comfort of children, and ease of maintenance. At the School, wearing of proper uniform of approved colour, design and pattern is mandatory. All buttons must be done up. Undergarments should also be worn properly. Tie, belt with buckle with school logo, Socks, Shoes with laces, School bag with school logo and water bottle are mandatory for all students. RF I-card will be issued to students after admission, Wearing I-D card is compulsory for all.

Scholarships and bursaries are available on merit- cum- means basis to eligible students.

Admission Procedure

Admission to School is based on minimum age of the Child and previous class attended in previous school subject to assessment of faculty about ability of child to keep up with the teaching standards at the School. School is fully English medium with compulsory spoken English. Teaching of all subjects shall be in English for which we will prepare students in next 3 years. School is adopting CBSE compliant syllabus. Children will be taught and motivated to speak English at all times in School. It expect them to do so while outside as well.

Minimum age for nursery is 3 years as on April 1, 2024. Child must be trained to take care of his/ her toilets at the time admission. Children requiring special attention or having any medical issue must be specifically notified by the parents at the time of admission.

At the time of admission, parents will be required to appear with child before Admission counsellor and fill the registration form. Counsellor will interact with parent and child and fill parent interaction form and child assessment form. The purpose of the forms is to assess the entitlements, eligibilities and responsibilities. If School agrees to admit child, it will be informed to parents and they will be expected to deposit fees. Once fee is deposited, the admission will be confirmed. Decision of School in admission and fees matter is final.

Once the admission is confirmed, parents will be expected to buy school uniform, books and stationary from shop of their choice. School will issue RF I D card. IDCard will be a pass to entry into School and availing bus facility.

No child in class 1 or above will be admitted without School leaving certificate of previous School.

Transport Facility

School provides transport facility to all children. It is payable separately and is entirely optional. The facility can be availed any time and can be left at any time during session. Transport facility once availed, is chargeable for whole session. The charges are based on block of distance from School to be notified separately. For temporary use of personal vehicles (self pick up) to bring the child to school or take away after school hours of the child availing school transport facility, a separate request is to be made by parent for every occasion addressed to transport in charge well in advance.

Children availing extra classes and remedial classes after school hours or availing sports facility after regular school hours are to be picked by the parent at their own arrangement. Where school arranges extra hours for all children, School will arrange transport. Such extra arrangements shall be notified to the parents at least one day in advance through concerned child only.

Entry to Bus is regulated by RF I-D card.

Our major policies

Student's responsibilities:

- Respect yourself, respect other students, and respect teachers.

Parents' responsibilities:

- Pay fees on time
 - Attend PTM regularly
- Take care of child, provide nutritious food in lunch box
 - Keep track of progress of your child
- Encourage your child by providing right atmosphere at home and prevent him / her from being influenced by undesirable influence from neighbourhood
 - Maintain personal hygiene of child

School Opposes:

- Corporal punishment and humiliation of children
 - Harassment, bullying, abusive and foul language
- Discrimination on caste, colour, complexion, religion, belief or sex
 - Teasing, humiliation, disruptive behaviour, violent behaviour,
 - Any kind of disrespect to other children, school staff ,and
- Consumption of alcohol, narcotic substance, chewing of pan, tobacco, gutka.

Transfer /withdrawal

If the child is to be transferred to other School, it must be notified well in advance at least by 3 months except in case of out station transfer of government servant parent. The due withdrawal application has to be submitted by parent / guardian.

If the child is being withdrawn after October, fee for whole session is to be paid.

Transfer certificate will be issued by the Coordinator or Principal on production of 'No dues' from all departments including transport, canteen and store charges.

Duplicate copy of TC will be issued on payment of Rs. 200/= only
